E-SAFETY PERFORMANCES

Performances for Key Stage 1 & 2

E-Safety is a growing concern for all schools and we think a drama performance is a fantastic way to highlight the issues and teach children important messages.

We offer 2 different performances each year - one for each Key Stage. Both plays explore issues including use of apps and games, privacy settings and keeping personal information safe online, cyber-bullying and who to go to for support and guidance if you feel unsafe online. For more information about the specific performances available this year take a look at our website.

Children watch the performance and take part in a question and answer session. We then offer follow up workshops which give children the chance to explore, discover and ask questions. Through thinking about the actions of the characters in the play, children develop their understanding of the choices available to them online and the potential consequences of these.

EYES OPEN - DRUG AND ALCOHOL AWARENESS FOR YEAR 6

Eyes Open has been touring schools since 2008 and is a proven way to engage Year 6 pupils in exploring drug and alcohol use.

The play is narrated by Ellie, an 11 year old girl who has just made the transition into high school. Through Ellie's family, pupils develop their understanding of legal and illegal drugs and alcohol, and across this fun and hard-hitting play, the consequences of drug and alcohol misuse are made clear for pupils.

Following the performance, pupils take part in a workshop where they work with the actors to explore the choices made by the characters and develop their understanding and opinions about drugs and alcohol.

We tour each show at Christmas and then make it available across the following year to celebrate events like World Book Day, National Storytelling Week and National Share a Story Month.

The performance is brought to you by 4 professional actors who turn your school hall into an exciting theatre space. The show is fun and engaging, full of original songs and loads of audience participation. We bring the panto atmosphere to school, but our shows are also educational and inspiring - the perfect balance!

We can also offer follow up workshops (or stand-alone workshops) exploring storytelling, character, structure or any aspect of a classic text.

THE MONKEY PROJECT

Perfect for KS2 development

An 8 week writing project

Uses drama activities, modelling and group writing to teach & embed skills

Culminates in a performance of your pupils' work by our actors

Optional SPaG sessions during the project

The Monkey Project is our big literacy project – which offers huge results for schools. The Monkey Project works by getting children excited about writing; engaging them in fast paced drama workshops which fire their imaginations and encourage them to be creative.

Each session is a combination of drama games, activities which model good writing and individual writing time, where children write a new story each week in their own Monkey Journal.

At the end of the school sessions we take away all of the Monkey Journals and read each story. We then select around 20 stories and create a performance which the children watch, during which each child is credited as the author of their story. Children watch in amazement as their stories are turned into songs, poems, raps, dramas, comedies, trailers and news reports.

We now offer the option to add Drama for SPaG sessions into your Monkey Project. You can start with SPaG workshops and then move into a shortened Monkey format where children demonstrate their learning in their pieces of writing.





DRAMA FOR SPaG

Book a 1 day workshop, a term-long project or a whole year of work.

Here at Altru, we love English and we believe that drama can be used to teach all aspects of the English curriculum to great success – including SPaG!

Drama for SPaG is a workshop (or series of workshops) using drama games and activities to help children learn SPaG rules and techniques.

Drama for SPaG workshops use innovative activities to enhance and embed skills in spelling, punctuation and grammar. Children get to try out a whole range of ideas and skills in a practical way, and then apply these ideas to written work back in class. We have 11 years' experience of working with children and our Artistic Director is a former English teacher, so you can be certain that Altru sessions will always be accurate, educational, engaging and accessible.

Book either a Drama for SPaG project or a Drama for SPaG day and choose the topics you'd like to work on. These might include:

- Perfect and progressive tense
- Expanded noun phrases
- Conjunctions
- Active and passive voice
-to name just a few!

- Fronted adverbials
- Subordinate clauses
- Word classes

HANSEL AND GRETEL

An exciting 45 minute performance - designed especially with Early Years learning in mind.

Our actors bring the traditional tale to life for your pupils in your school hall. The performance uses music and puppetry and your pupils become part of the cast as they play the birds, create the sounds of the forest and sing the travelling song with Hansel and Gretel.

The performance starts with an introduction to the puppets and with your pupils learning the song. Following this, everyone watches and joins in with the story, and afterwards children ask and answer questions about what they have seen and heard.

The performance is clearly linked to the key areas of learning and development and the Early Learning Goals set out in the EYFS Statutory Framework. The curriculum links document is available on our website or get in touch to request a copy.


To date we've developed and delivered workshops on topics as diverse as:
