A Midsummer Night's Dream is a play. Plays are written in a different way to stories; there is no description of people or places. Mostly plays are dialogue (a conversation) between two or more people.

Using modern language, try writing a conversation between Hermia and her father Egeus, based on what you have learnt so far about the characters.

The template below should give you some ideas of how to set it out and we've done the first lines to help you!

(Also don't worry about speech marks – in a play script you don't need them).
